Please mark the envelope 'Photography Competition'.

All image files must be of a resolution of 300 dpi.

Finalists chosen to be part of the exhibition must provide a photographic print of their work, clearly labelled at the reverse with photographers name and the title of the photograph.

If your photograph includes anyone under the age of 18, it is your responsibility to obtain necessary permission to take their picture and submit it for exhibition.

By submitting a photograph and agreeing to the Terms and Conditions, you are consenting to the exclusive, royalty free use of your photograph by The Chipping Campden Information Centre and the Bantam Tearooms on their websites, social media, and in the exhibition whether as a finalist or on our digital display. Photographs will also be used in advertising and press, both during and after the exhibition.

Any photographs used will be credited to the photographer, but any hard copies submitted will not be returned to the photographer.

All entries must be the original work of the entrant and must not infringe the rights of any other party. In the event of any such infringement the photographer agrees to indemnify
